BUILDING REGULATIONS DOCUMENT PART K: PROTECTION FROM FALLING

Design of guarding for all buildings

In a building that may be used by children under five years of age during normal use, guarding should be constructed in accordance with both of the following;

a. To prevent children being held fast by the guarding: ensure that a 100mm sphere cannot pass through any openings in the guarding.

b. To prevent children from readily being able to climb the guarding: avoid horizontal rails.

Single family dwellings Stairs, landings, ramps, edges of internal floors	900mm
External balconies, including Juliette balconies and edges of roof	1100mm
Glazing in all buildings at opening windows except roof windows (Except in the case of a window in a roof where the bottom of the opening may be 600mm above the floor)	800mm
At glazing to changes of levels to provide containment	800mm
